Changes to procedure for examination of the Record

Judicial Committee (General Appellate Jurisdiction) Rules
(Amendment) Order 2008 (SI 2008 No 300)

Order in Council SI 2008 No. 300, Judicial Committee (General Appellate Jurisdiction) Rules (Amendment) Order 2008 was made on the 12th February 2008. The Order removes the current requirement for parties to attend the Judicial Committee to examine the proof of the Record with a member of the Registry staff present. The order is due to come into force on the 4th March 2008.

As soon as parties have agreed the Record in accordance with Schedule A, *one draft copy* of the Record for reproduction should now be sent to the Registry for approval.(Article A of this order amends Schedule A to the 1982 Rules.)

If the Record has not been prepared in accordance with the Rules or is otherwise unsatisfactory the Registrar may give directions for it to be amended, and if so may direct that a draft be returned to the Registry for further approval.

Once the Registry has approved the Record the appellant shall arrange for 16 copies to be transmitted to the Registry and copies given to each party who has entered an appearance.
